Rules

Below a concise version of the rules of Unihockey is given. In case these rules aren't sufficient the referee is always right, even if he isn't! Every match takes 13 minutes, with 2 minutes between matches. A team loses the match automatically if they are not present at the starting time of the match.

 Playing the ball with both sides of the stick Stopping the ball with your feet/leg Protecting the ball with your body Standing offside (there is no offside) Scoring from the whole field Playing the ball against the boarding Playing the ball behind the goal Continuously changing players while the match is going on. Scoring directly from a free shot. A light push with the shoulder to get the ball 	 Scoring with your feet/leg Playing the ball with your hands/head/arms. Hitting someones stick Constantly blocking someone's stick Waving your stick above the hip. Catching the ball out of the air above the knee Playing the ball lying down/sitting. Putting the stick between someone's legs. Entering the keepers zone as a field players Hindering a player of the opposing team body checks
