Rules Badminton

Team size: 2+

Duration of a game: 10 min (2 min in between matches)

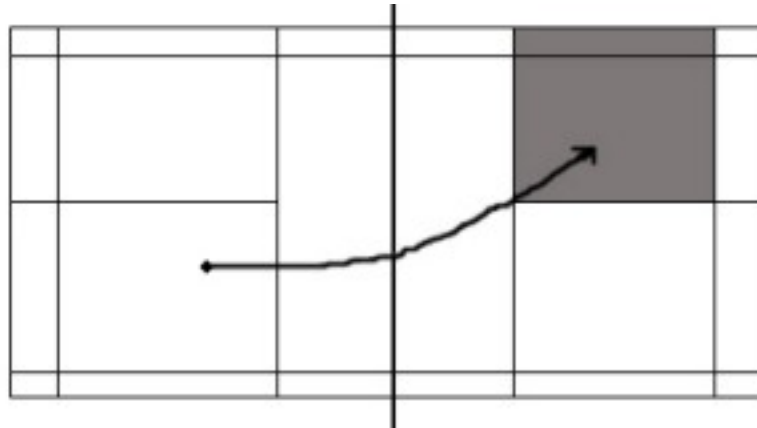
- A team loses the match automatically if they are not present at the starting time of the match.
- Two matches will be played at the same time.
- The game is played in doubles and scoring is according to the rally-point system. This means that you can score points whether you served or not.

Start of the match

The team on the left side of the bracket may start with service.

Service

Serving the shuttle has to be done underhand (below the shoulder). The service has to be played diagonally between the service lines (see the image below.)



General rules:

- The game is played in doubles.
- A point is scored if the opposing team makes a fault.
- The playing field consists of the area between the outer lines.
- Points will be added up until the game time is over.
- The team with the most points after 10 minutes wins.
- The referees are always right and will be treated with respect!

Service:

- If the receiver makes a fault, the server scores a point and serves again from the alternate side of the court:
 - **Right side** if the server's score is **even**.
 - **Left side** if the server's score is **odd**.
- If the server makes a fault, the receiver scores a point and takes over as the new server.

Faults:

A player commits a fault if:

- the shuttle hits the ground on their side;
- the player hits the shuttle into the net or out of bounds;
- their team hits the shuttle twice;
- the shuttle hits the ceiling.
